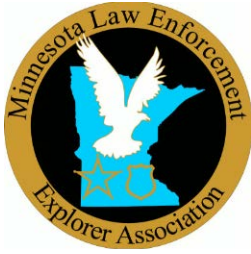
OLD BUSINESS

D. Brian Swerine- Boy scouts of America/ Northern Star Council

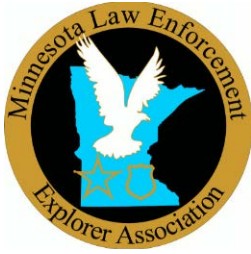
- 1. Exploring Awards Dinner Week of March 20th**
