March 1999  
Minutes Summary

Meeting was called to order by President Gary Cayo. Those attending the meeting introduced themselves. Special attendees came from Duluth.

Secretary Cory Manthei read minutes for the last meeting. The minutes were approved and accepted.

Treasure Lynne Tellers handed out copies of the financial report. Expenses included: cost for past two meetings; Fall Planning Conference; re-chartering fees; scholarships paid out to explorers; and gifts for advisors for the 1999 Minnesota Law Enforcement Explorer Conference. A donation towards the scholarship fund was received from Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #3 for \$200.00. Donations are still being sought for the scholarship fund.

It was noted at this time that Lynne Tellers would not be attending the state conference because she will be enrolled at the FBI National Academy. *Best of luck Lynne, make us proud!!!!*

Vice President Steve Labatt continues his commitments of learning to be city council person for Chanhassen. Prior to this meeting he expressed his concerns to President Cayo that he may not be able to proceed through the board positions. Vice President Labatt will make his intention know before the state conference.

The Minnesota Law Enforcement Conference will be quickly upon us. Plans are progressing well. The possible resort construction we were told for last year was delayed.
