### **ATTENTION ADVISORS** ***Important 2020 Conference Changes***

**Our registration process has changed**

**Registration Check in is from 15:00 to 19:00 Thursday at the Double Tree second floor.**

This is to notify you and your other advisors of the changes to housing of explorers going forward. This will be not only when the Association does the housing but should be how you would do housing on any official Explorer Events.

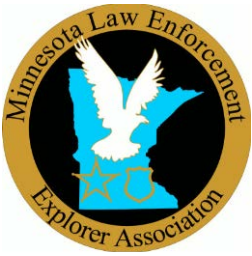
- Rooms will be separated between Male and Female rooms.
- Explorers between 14 and 17 will be housed together.
- Explorers between 18 and 20 will be housed together.
- Explorers 21 would not be able to attend as explorers and must register as Adult Leadership.

#### **Changes for 2020 State Conference.**

- With the new housing rules and to keep cost down your post may be sharing rooms to make sure rooms are full. You will be notified as soon as possible when this happens. Explorers from different posts will not be sharing a bed. They will be sharing the hotel room. You do have an option to opt out of this by paying an additional fee to fill the room. This fee will be based on the number of people in the room and the number needed to fill the room. This fee will be as little 175.00 or as much as 350.00. You need to inform us ASAP if this is what you want to use this option.
- Additional housing: If you have an explorer that is going through a change in sexual orientation, we must know about this when registration paperwork is due. Per Learning for Life rules if the explorer has the sexual organs of a male, then they are considered a male for the conference and would be housed in a male's room. The same would go for a Female. This info would also come into play if they are sharing rooms with other post. The more info we know with the paperwork helps us fix any issues before check-in.
- Food Changes: Soda will no longer be offered at Lunch and Dinner. Lemonade will be provided at Lunch and Milk for Dinner along with water. If you also have food issues you need to inform us at the time registration paperwork is due. **NO CHANGES CAN BE MADE AT THE CONFERENCE.**
- Awards dinner: Your command staff is welcome to attend but you must RSVP with the number of individuals attending by April 10, 2020. We will continue paying for one of your command staff and a guest to attend. If additional individuals attend your post will be charged for the dinner. This is due to the continued issues with lack of space, food shortages, and additional cost for of the all extra people attending.
- We will no longer be providing pens in your boxes at registration as we have done in the past.
- You need to preregister for Drill Team as this will only be only on Friday of the conference.
- This year we will not have a dance or entertainment on Saturday night.

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Like last year the registration process has changed, and you will need to use the new process to help with all the housing changes. This will be a Microsoft Access Database that you will need to install on a computer. After you have completed all your data entry and clicked submit this will start your registration process.

**With the new housing rules due dates will be strictly enforced! If you must make a change after any of the dates you must contact DuWayne to discuss the situation.**

Your registration is due by 1200 Monday March 2, 2020 no exceptions. If you post is not registered by this date and time you post will not attend. No changes other than a total drop will be allowed after March 27, 2020. After March 27, 2019 no refunds will be given. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact any board member.

Cost of the conference will be \$395.00 this year. Registration fees can be paid later. The cost for this year pistol shoot will be \$30.00 per person.

Report Writing will be an event this year again. It will work similar as Job interview. Each post will get 2 slots and those explorers will do the event at the same time. If more than 2 reports are found from a post all the reports will be discarded. More information will be provided in the future or at the conference.

This year academic sessions are open for the entire post to attend, however, only one test per post will be allowed. If two tests are found to be submitted both will be disqualified.

The Drill Team event will be offered as a **Friday Only** event at this year's conference. When you register for the conference you will have the option to sign up for this event.

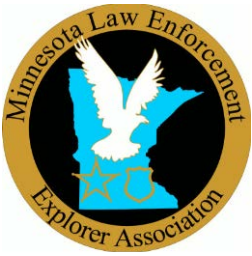
You will see that the Health form that needs to be completed and retained in your records. Part C has been removed from the form as you do not need to complete that part. Please make sure you keep this paperwork with you at the conference.

***If you are waiting for money to start your registration, please do not wait and register your post, if you miss the deadline your post will not be able to attend.***

**Remember if you do not let us know ahead of time of any special request, we won't be able to honor the request. This included special diet requests.**

**Please notify us of any changes so we can keep the hotels informed of the rooms needed for the conference. Remember March 27, 2020 no changes can be made other than a total drop.**

**There are no limits to the number of explorers and advisors you wish to bring!**

Please check into your hotel and then come to our registration desk to check in with us and get your Conference information. Remember that most hotels have a check in time of 1500 hours or after.

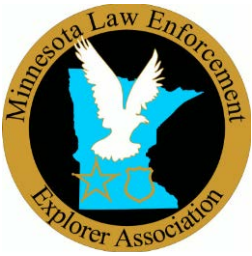
